WHERE: Peninsula Golf Club* (Private Club, 18 hole par 72 course)

WHO: All Treasurers and their deputies, sponsors, vendors, family, friends and acquaintances. (Golf experience is not a requirement.)

WHAT: SCRAMBLE FORMAT GOLF TOURNAMENT (See rules attached)

HOW MUCH: \$65.00 per person (includes green fees and a seat in the golf cart)

SPECIAL INFORMATION: ALL REGISTRATIONS FOR THE GOLF TOURNAMENT MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN JUNE 1st, 2008.

This is necessary to provide proper confirmation to the golf course of the number of tees needed.

*DIRECTIONS TO GOLF CLUB: From Red Lion, go south on Lincoln Street to First Street (1 Blk) turn left and follow First Street to Golf Course Rd (intersection with Wendy's Drive-In and McDonalds). Turn right on Golf Course Rd. to Lindberg Rd. (just beyond top of the hill) turn left onto Lindberg Road and follow into Golf Club parking lot. It is about 2.5 miles from the hotel. Maps will be available at the information desk at the Conference Registration desk.

WSACT Tournament Rules:

1. All players must have a set of clubs.
2. Private coolers are not allowed on the course.
3. The course dress code: Men – shirt with collar, polo type or “tee” shirt; trousers, walking or Bermuda type shorts. Women-blouse, shirt, sweater, full – length sun tops or “tee” shirt, pants or walking or Bermuda type shorts. Not allowed: swim-wear, gym shorts, cut-offs, undershirts, short-shorts, bare midriff, sun tops, tube tops or tank tops.
4. The format is a scramble with four person teams. This means that all golfers will tee off and the team shall decide the best ball to play. All players will hit their next shot from the “best” ball position and other succeeding “best” locations and so on until on the green. There will be a two drive minimum per player.

Since a wide range of golf experience will be exhibited on (and off) the course, winter rules will apply. In other words, you may (on the fairway or in rough) position the ball within one club length of original location as long as the ball is no closer to the hole. On the green, all putts shall be within 6” of the original location but no closer to the hole.

5. Prizes! We will have a variety of prizes, so come join the fun!
6. The purpose of the tournament is FUN! **All players must check in by 12:00 p.m. with the tournament coordinator (Jeff Colvin) to insure that they are ready to tee off at their pre-arranged time. The first tee time is at 12:30 p.m.**

Jeff Colvin is the husband of Deputy Jill Colvin of the Clallam County Treasurer’s Office. It is through his membership in Peninsula Golf Club we have this opportunity to play this great course.
